Street Church is outdoor worship and lunch every week at Franklin Square Park in downtown DC. It is sponsored by the Church of the Epiphany and our hope is that Street Church will provide a place for the homeless and others to worship and build community. Street Church is a place to pray for our city, to raise up the concerns of the streets, and to bring alive a presence of hope and faith and hospitality. We are joined by other Episcopal parishes in the diocese of Washington who are our partners in this ministry.
